SECTION #1

A \$500.00 deposit will reserve a puppy. Deposits are NON-REFUNDABLE. There are no refunds once the puppy has been reserved, either partial or full. In the event you do not return a signed copy of the contract, the buyer acknowledges that the action of putting down a deposit/transfer of funds electronically will automatically enter the buyer into a contractual agreement of the terms herein.

Nanny fees are Determined based upon location should this apply. Puppies will never be shipped. In extreme cases puppies can be nannied to returning clients. Every effort will be made by the seller to assure that the puppy is healthy when it is delivered to the buyer. The buyer is responsible for all medical expenses incurred from date of delivery.

SECTION #2

The buyer must take the dog to a veterinarian for a complete physical examination within 5 days of receiving the puppy. The cost of the examination will be paid by the buyer. If the Buyer does not take the puppy to a veterinarian within 5 days, this warranty is void. The seller must be notified immediately of the results of the examination if a problem exists. If the veterinarian finds the dog to be a poor health risk or detects any physical health problems that would require further veterinary care, the buyer must notify the seller IMMEDIATELY. A report of the results from the veterinarian must be faxed to the seller within 24 hours. The seller's veterinarian will verify the results.

SECTION #3

The puppy will be guaranteed for six months against any life threatening defects. This includes severe hip dysphasia which requires surgery to correct. It also covers kidney, heart, pancreases, spine, and liver problems of a severe life threatening nature. If the puppy is found to have a life threatening defect, a complete report from the buyer's veterinarian must be faxed to the seller within 48 hours after the determination. If the puppy dies within this six month period, the buyer will pay for a necropsy to ascertain the reason for death. If the reason is congenital, the seller will replace the puppy with one of the same value, to be determined by the seller. A replacement puppy may not be available immediately. The buyer will wait until a puppy from a future litter is available. The buyer is responsible for all shipping expenses to and from the seller on a replacement puppy. A monetary amount up to the purchase price will be made at the seller's discretion for purposes of medical care to be determined by the seller and Va. Tech Vet Hospital. Seller will not cover general veterinarian bills. Puppies sold with a Limited Registration also have a health guarantee. The health guarantee is not valid if the dog has been sold or transferred to a new owner. If the pup in your care has been treated for any injury the contract is null and void for that injury.

SECTION #4

The health guarantee does not cover the following: Treatment for internal or external parasites or bacteria, cherry eye, loose hips, loose knees, skin allergies, elongated soft palate, and small or collapsed nostrils, bad or uneven bites, undescended testicles, Demodex, mange, inguinal or umbilical hernias, fleas, ticks, ear mites, coccidia, kennel cough, Giardia, campylobacter and thyroid dysfunction as these issues are not life threatening and can be remedied quickly.

SECTION #5

There is no guarantee or warranty that the buyer will be able to show or breed the puppy, regardless of show or breeding potential at the time of purchase. There is no money back if you, the buyer decides the pup isn't to your liking.

PUPS LEFT OVER 12 WEEKS PAST PICKUP DATE WHETHER PAID OR NOT PAID WILL FORFIT ALL MONEY PAID TO DATE.

SECTION #6

All dogs sold are AKC limited registration unless buyer has purchased additional breeding rights from seller. Limited puppies will not be bred with express opinion of seller under the rules of this contract.

Buyer understands that this contract is under the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth of Va, in the County of Botetourt It is agreed that the place of venue shall be in Botetourt County, Virginia.

Bringing Your Frenchie Puppy Home

Your new puppy should adjust to his or her new home in a few days.

With the stress of a new environment, puppies are often at high risk for Coccidia and Giardia,

These are treatable. They are brought on by the stress of shipping, a new home, new food, new people, and change of climate or surroundings. All puppies are treated for Coccidiosis and Giardia before they leave us. Preventive Treatment however, is not a guarantee the puppy will not respond to the above issues. If they don't, they are rarely serious and should be diagnosed and treated by a Licensed Vet if symptoms persist for several days. Both parasites are easily treated. We do not cover the treatment for the either.

Giardia is a ubiquitous parasite and can be found everywhere, in puddles of water, the grass, dirt, or having the puppy outdoors or in

public places prior to their third set of vaccines! Also, if additional family pets are in the home, they can be carriers, and I recommend getting a stool sample checked by your Vet after you get your puppy home. If your puppy does have loose stools make sure your Vet also does a direct smear to look for an overload of bacteria, as this can also be a cause of loose stools.
